

The Challenge: Chef Mike's Charcoal Restaurant is located in Indianapolis. The area's municipal supply is quite hard (>30 grains per gallon). Previous water treatment consisted of a single softener on the supply that only serviced the hot water in the building. The softener had been removed and there were ongoing issues with all of the water fixtures and equipment, particularly the steam ovens.

The Solution: One ¾" Scaletron was installed on the incoming main water service line in order to treat the entire building. The customer's goal was to prevent scale in the steam oven, ice machine, toilets and other fixtures.

Results: The customer is delighted with the results of the installation and maintaining a salt based system is a thing of the past. The steam ovens are scale free and scale accumulation throughout the restaurant has ceased to be a problem.
